

Happy Anniversary



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Leaf and Floral background (Hero Arts); Fillable Frames #4 (papertrey ink)
- **Ink:** VersaMark ink (Tsukineko)
- **Paper:** Smooth White CS, Ebony CS (Bazzill); Pink Pirouette CS (Stampin' Up!)
- **Accessories:** Lace/Pearl ribbon (May Arts); Gillian White flowers, Mini Rose Mid Release Fuchsia flowers (Prima); bone folder, Stampin' Dimensionals, paper snips (Stampin' Up!); Pearlescent White Pearl embossing powder, Primary Ebony Regular embossing powder (WOW! Embossing); Heat It! tool (Ranger); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); tape (optional)(Scotch); Fillable Frames #4 die (papertrey ink); Big Shot (Sizzix); 450 Quick Dry adhesive (Helmar)

Dimensions:

- Smooth White CS: a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece, a 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece and a scrap piece
- Ebony CS: a 4 ⅜" x 4 ⅜" piece
- Pink Pirouette CS: a 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece
- Lace/Pearl ribbon: a 5" piece

Directions:

1. Stamp the background flourish image onto the 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Smooth White CS, using VersaMark ink.
2. Sprinkle Pearlescent White Pearl embossing powder over the image. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
3. Lay the 5" piece of Lace/Pearl ribbon over the embossed 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Smooth White CS, about 1 ¾" up from the bottom of the CS. Wrap the ends to the back of the CS and stick them down using double sided adhesive. You can also stick the ends down using regular Scotch tape.
4. Center and stick the embossed 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Smooth White CS to the 4 ⅜" x 4 ⅜" piece of Ebony CS, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Die cut a frame from the scrap piece of Smooth White CS, using the Fillable Frames # 4 die and the Big Shot.
6. Stamp the frame image onto the die cut Smooth White CS label, using VersaMark ink.
7. Sprinkle Pearlescent White Pearl embossing powder over the image. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
8. Stamp the greeting onto the center of the Smooth White CS label, using VersaMark ink.
9. Sprinkle Primary Ebony Regular embossing powder over the image. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
10. Stick the greeting label to the matted 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Smooth White CS, directly over the center of the lace/pearl ribbon, using a double layer of Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Center and stick the matted 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Smooth White CS to the 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Pink Pirouette CS, using double sided adhesive.
12. Fold the 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" card base.

13. Center and stick the matted 4 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Smooth White CS to the front of the card, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
14. Cut the wire from the back of the two small pink flowers, using paper snips.
15. Stick all three flowers to the top right corner of the greeting label, in a cluster, using 450 Quick Dry adhesive. Let dry. You're done!
