

Imagine The Possibilities



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Word Play (Stampin' Up!)
- **Ink:** VersaMark ink (Tsukineko); Basic Black Craft ink (Stampin' Up!)
- **Paper:** Daffodil Delight CS (Stampin' Up!); Ebony CS (Bazzill); Sun Kiss Collection (Prima Marketing)
- **Accessories:** Wonderful Wings Grand Shapeabilities, Classic Triple Scallop Edgeabilities, Grand Calibur (Spellbinders); Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon (May Arts); Primary Ebony Superfine embossing powder, Black Glint embossing glitter, Pearl Gold Sparkle embossing glitter (WOW! Embossing); embossing buddy, mini glue dots, stamp-a-majig (optional), Stampin' Dimensionals (Stampin' Up!); Heat It! tool (Ranger); black rhinestones (Kaiser Craft); hot glue (Martha Stewart); flower filigree (Craft Store); Removable Tape Matte (Scotch); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); Wax paper (Dollar Store)

Dimensions:

- Daffodil Delight CS: a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece and a scrap piece
- Ebony CS: a 5" x 5 ½" piece and a scrap piece
- Bliss DP: a 4" x 5" piece
- Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon: a 2" piece, a 6" piece and a 7" piece

Directions:

1. Fold the 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of Daffodil Delight CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" card base.
2. Lay the "floral" die from the Classic Triple Scallop Edgeability across the bottom of the 5" x 5 ½" piece of Ebony CS, positioning the bottom of the die about ½" up from the bottom of the Ebony CS. Stick the die to the CS using Removable Tape Matte. Run this through the Grand Calibur.
3. Lay the "scallop" die from the Classic Triple Scallop Edgeability across the bottom of the 5" x 5 ½" piece of Ebony CS, underneath the die cut section. Stick the die to the CS using Removable Tape Matte. Run this through the Grand Calibur.
4. Stick the 4" x 5" piece of Bliss DP to the die cut Ebony CS, leaving equal borders on the top, left and right hand sides, using double sided adhesive.
5. Rub an embossing buddy over the Bliss DP. Lay the 7" piece of Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon across the bottom of the Bliss DP for proper positioning. Stamp the greeting onto the bottom left corner of the Bliss DP, just above the ribbon, using Basic Black Craft ink. Remove the ribbon.
6. Sprinkle Primary Ebony Superfine embossing powder over the greeting. Tap off any excess embossing powder. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
7. Lay the 7" piece of Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon across the bottom of the Bliss DP. Wrap the ends around to the back of the CS and stick them down, using double sided adhesive.
8. Create a "loop" from the 6" piece of Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon, by folding the two ends of ribbon onto themselves and sticking them together, using hot glue.

9. Position the “loop” onto the first piece of ribbon. Wrap a 2” piece of Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon around the loop and the first piece of ribbon and stick it down, creating a faux bow, as shown in the video, using hot glue.
10. Center and stick the matted Bliss DP to the front of the card, using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
11. Die cut a butterfly background and an outline butterfly from a scrap piece of Daffodil Delight CS, using the Wonderful Wings Grand Shapeabilities and the Grand Calibur.
12. Die cut an outline butterfly from a scrap piece of Ebony CS, using the Wonderful Wings Grand Shapeabilities and the Grand Calibur.
13. Pat the die cut butterfly background onto a VersaMark pad. Sprinkle the die cut with Pearl Gold Sparkle embossing glitter. Tap off any excess glitter. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing glitter has melted.
14. Stick the Daffodil Delight outline butterfly to the Ebony outline butterfly, using mini glue dots. You want to gently fold the wings up so your butterfly has dimension.
15. Stick the matted Daffodil Delight outline butterfly to the butterfly background, using mini glue dots.
16. Ink up one end of a flower filigree with VersaMark ink. Sprinkle Black Glint embossing glitter over the flower filigree. Tap off any excess embossing glitter. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing glitter has melted. Repeat on the other side of the flower filigree.
17. Fold the flower filigree in half. Stick the folded portion of the flower filigree to the butterfly die cut, just under the Ebony CS layer, using a dab of hot glue.
18. Stick the butterfly to the card, in the upper right hand corner, using Stampin’ Dimensionals.
19. Stick six black rhinestones to the card, three in the upper left hand corner and three just under the greeting. You’re done!
