

# Birthday Washi Tape Card



## **Supplies:**

- **Stamps:** Birthday Basics (papertrey ink)
- **Ink:** Jet Black Archival ink (Ranger); YR23 and RV13 Copic markers (Copic)
- **Paper:** Stamper's Select White CS, Hibiscus Burst CS (papertrey ink)
- **Accessories:** bone folder, paper snips (Stampin' Up!); pink polka dot washi tape, yellow polka dot washi tape (craft store); clear rhinestones (Kaisercraft); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web)

## **Dimensions:**

- Hibiscus Burst CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece
- Stamper's Select White CS: a 4" x 5 ¼" piece

## **Directions:**

1. Fold the 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Hibiscus Burst CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base. Set aside for a moment.
2. Cut a fishtail in both ends of a 3 ½" piece of yellow polka dot washi tape, using paper snips.
3. Stick the yellow polka dot washi tape to the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS, ⅜" down from the top of the CS.
4. Cut a fishtail in both ends of a 4 ½" piece of pink polka dot washi tape, using paper snips.
5. Stick the pink polka dot washi tape to the 4" x 5 ½" piece of White CS, ¼" down from the previous piece of Washi tape.
6. Repeat steps 4 and 5, sticking one yellow piece and one pink piece of washi tape to the CS. You want to make sure that you are alternating the colors of washi tape.
7. Stamp the "Happy Birthday" greeting onto each piece of washi tape, using Jet Black Archival ink.
8. Stamp the "and many more" greeting onto the bottom right corner of the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS, just below the bottom piece of washi tape, using Jet Black Archival ink.
9. Color two clear rhinestones, using an YR23 Copic marker. Color two clear rhinestones, using an RV13 Copic marker. Set aside to dry.
10. Center and stick the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS to the card base, using double sided adhesive.
11. Stick the colored rhinestones to the card, as shown. You're done!
