

Thanks Washi Tape Card



Supplies:

- **Paper:** Stamper's Select White CS (papertrey ink)
- **Accessories:** bone folder, paper snips, Rhinestone Basic Jewels (Stampin' Up!); Scene Thickers alphabet stickers (Amy Tangerine - American Crafts); 3D Foam (thermo-web); assorted washi or tissue tape (craft store)

Dimensions:

- Stamper's Select White CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece and a 4" x 5 ¼" piece
- Washi tape: seven 5" pieces (all in various heights and patterns)

Directions:

1. Fold the 4 ¼" x 11" piece of White CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base. Set aside for a moment.
2. Stick the first pattern of washi tape to the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS, about ⅛" up from the bottom. You want to leave an equal amount of the washi tape overhanging the CS on each side. If you don't have washi tape, you can use various coordinating pieces of patterned paper or ribbons.
3. Continue sticking various patterns of washi tape to the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS, leaving a ⅛" space in between each pattern, until the entire piece of CS is covered.
4. Wrap each end of the washi tape around to the back of the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS and stick them down.
5. Using the Scene Thickers alphabet stickers, stick the letters for the word "thanks" to the card, along one of the pieces of washi tape, as shown.
6. Stick a clear rhinestone to the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS, one on each side of the sentiment.
7. Center and stick the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White CS to the card base, using 3D Foam. You're done!
