

Baby Card



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Mat Stack # 2 Collection (papertrey ink)
- **Ink:** VersaMark ink (Tsukineko)
- **Paper:** Bashful Blue CS, Subtles Patterns DP (Stampin' Up!); Smooth White CS (Bazzill)
- **Accessories:** Primary Ebony Regular embossing powder, Nice Ice Blue embossing glitter (WOW! Embossing); embossing buddy, bone folder, Bashful Blue 1" Double Stitched Grosgrain ribbon (retired), mini glue dots, Stampin' Dimensionals, paper snips, White Satin ribbon (Stampin' Up!); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); 1" red liner tape (Blockheads Paper Arts); Heat It! tool (Ranger); pearls (Dollar Store); White baker's twine (Stampin' Up!); Classic Decorative Inserts Three Edgeabilities, Classic Brackets die, Grand Calibur (Spellbinders); paper trimmer and scoring blade (Fiskars); Removable Tape Matte, tape (Scotch); Mat Stack #2 die (papertrey ink); 1 1/8" Circle punch (EK Success)

Dimensions:

- Bashful Blue CS: a 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece and a scrap piece
- Smooth White CS: a scrap piece
- Bashful Blue Patterns DP: a 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" piece of the polka dot pattern
- Bashful Blue 1" Double Stitched Grosgrain ribbon: a 7" piece
- White Satin ribbon: a 7" piece
- White baker's twine: a 4" piece and a 12" piece

Directions:

1. Score the 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece of Bashful Blue CS at 4 1/4", using a paper trimmer and scoring blade.
2. With the 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece of Bashful Blue CS laying in a portrait manner, lay the Classic Decorative Inserts Three Edgeabilities die onto the CS, aligning the bottom of the die about 1/4" up from the bottom of the CS. Stick the die to the CS, using a couple pieces of Removable Tape Matte, and run it through the Grand Calibur.
3. Carefully remove the die from the CS. Pop out any of the small areas of CS that may not have come out, using paper snips.
4. Lay the Classic Brackets die onto the 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece of Bashful Blue CS, aligning it just underneath the die cut section. Stick the die to the CS, using a couple pieces of Removable Tape Matte, and run it through the Grand Calibur.
5. Carefully remove the die from the CS.
6. Fold the 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" piece of Bashful Blue CS along the score line, creasing it with a bone folder, creating a 4 1/4" x 5 1/2" card base.
7. Stick a 5 1/2" piece of 1" red liner tape to the bottom of the inside of the card, about 1/4" up from the bottom of the CS. Make sure that the red liner tape is nice and smooth.
8. Remove the backing from the red liner tape. Sprinkle Nice Ice Blue embossing glitter over the red liner tape. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing glitter has melted.

9. Pat the two 5 ½" sides of the 2 ½" x 5 ½" piece of polka dot pattern DP onto a VersaMark pad. Sprinkle Nice Ice Blue embossing glitter over the two 5 ½" sides. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing glitter has melted.
10. Lay the 7" piece of Bashful Blue 1" Double Stitched Grosgrain ribbon over the center of the 2 ½" x 5 ½" piece of polka dot pattern DP. Wrap the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the DP and stick them down, using double sided adhesive.
11. Lay the 7" piece of White Satin ribbon over the Bashful Blue ribbon. Wrap the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the DP and stick them down using double sided adhesive. Stick a piece of tape over the ends of the ribbons to assure that they will not come apart.
12. Wrap a 4" piece of White baker's twine under the White Satin ribbon. Tie it into a double knot, toward the left hand side of the ribbon. Trim off any excess, using paper snips.
13. Stick the 2 ½" x 5 ½" piece of polka dot pattern DP to the front of the card, about ⅜" down from the top of the card, using double sided adhesive.
14. Die cut a label from the scrap piece of Smooth White CS, using the Mat Stack # 2 die and the Grand Calibur.
15. Stamp the label image onto the die cut label, using VersaMark ink.
16. Sprinkle Nice Ice Blue embossing glitter over the label image. Tap off any excess. Heat with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
17. Stamp the "baby" greeting onto a scrap piece of Bashful Blue CS, using VersaMark ink.
18. Sprinkle Primary Ebony Regular embossing powder over the "baby" greeting. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
19. Center the "baby" greeting in the window of a 1 ¼" Circle punch and punch it out.
20. Pat the edges of the punched out baby greeting onto a VersaMark pad. Sprinkle Nice Ice Blue embossing glitter on the edges. Tap off any excess. Heat it with a heat tool until the embossing glitter has melted.
21. Center and stick the "baby" greeting to the die cut label, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
22. Stick a small pearl on each side of the greeting label.
23. Stick the label to the card front, directly over the ribbon and centering it between the left and right sides, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
24. Tie the 12" piece of White Satin ribbon into a bow. Trim off the ends, on an angle, using paper snips.
25. Stick the bow to the front of your card, directly over the baker's twine knot, using mini glue dots. You're done!
