

# Happy Birthday



## **Supplies:**

- **Ink:** Early Espresso Craft ink (Stampin' Up!); Popsicle Blue Maya Mists (Maya Road)
- **Paper:** Crumb Cake CS (Stampin' Up!); Java CS (Bazzill); Life is Good Collection DP (Echo Park)
- **Accessories:** paper snips, Stampin' Dimensionals (Stampin' Up!); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); Coffee Gingham ribbon, Leaf Green Zipper Trim, Jonathon Chipboard Alphabet Letters, Mini Triangle Banner Canvas Pieces, Ruffle Blossom Golden Yellow and Turquoise, Metal Mini Love Hangers, Slushie Blue twine cording, Mini Kraft tags (Maya Road); Heat It! tool, Mini Mister (Ranger); Clear Braille embossing powder (Wow!); Hot Glue (Martha Stewart); Tombow multi-purpose liquid adhesive (Tombow); red liner tape (Simon Says Stamp)

## **Dimensions:**

- Java CS: a 12" x 12" piece, a 9 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 10" piece and a 3 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 5 <sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" piece
- Crumb Cake CS: an 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece
- Honey Comb DP: a 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece
- Coffee Gingham Ribbon: a 14" piece and two 4" pieces
- Slushie Blue twine cording: two 3" pieces
- Leaf Green Zipper trim: a 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece
- Photos: three 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 5 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" photos

## **Directions:**

1. Cover the chipboard letters for your title with Early Espresso Craft ink. Sprinkle each letter with Clear Braille embossing powder. Tap off any excess embossing powder. Heat each letter with a heat tool, until the embossing powder has melted. Set aside for a moment.
2. Fill a Mini Mister <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> full with water and then fill the remainder of the mister with Maya Mist Popsicle Blue. I pulled the Maya Mist out of the original spray bottle with an eye dropper.
3. Spritz the six Mini Triangle Banner canvas pieces with the created mist. Set aside to dry.
4. Thread the six spritzed canvas triangles onto the 14" piece of Coffee Gingham trim. Make sure that the trim is up through the bottom hole of the triangle then down through the top hole, so that the trim is across the triangle piece.
5. Stick the 9 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 10" piece of Java CS to the top right hand corner of the 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece of Crumb Cake CS, with double sided adhesive. You want the 10" side of the Java CS to be aligned with the right hand edge of the Crumb Cake CS.
6. Run red liner tape along the fabric on the 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece of Leaf Green Zipper Trim.
7. Peel the red backing from the red liner tape and stick the Zipper Trim to the bottom of the 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece of Honey Comb DP. You will stick the fabric to the back of the DP, so that you have the zipper portion of the trim exposed along the bottom edge of the DP.
8. Center and stick the 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 9 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece of DP to the 9 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" x 10" piece of Java CS, with double sided adhesive.
9. Lay the banner along the left hand side of the 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" piece of Crumb Cake CS. Wrap the ends of the ribbon around to the back of the CS and stick them down, with double sided adhesive.
10. Evenly space the banner triangles. Stick each triangle to the page with a mini glue dot.
11. Lay the "happy" chipboard title along the left hand side of the page, staggering the letters in between the banner triangles. Stick each letter to the page with Stampin' Dimensionals.

12. Center and stick the "birthday" chipboard title to the bottom of the page, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid adhesive.
13. Center and stick the 11  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 11  $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Crumb Cake CS to the 12" x 12" piece of Java CS, with double sided adhesive.
14. Take a 4" piece of Coffee Gingham trim and insert the end through the hole of a Kraft mini tag. Tie a 3" piece of Slushie Blue twine cording around the ends of the 4" piece of Coffee Gingham trim. Repeat with a second tag.
15. Stick a 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " photo in the top left hand corner of the 9  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9  $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of DP, using double sided adhesive.
16. Stick a 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " photo in the bottom right hand corner of the 9  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9  $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of DP, using double sided adhesive.
17. Center and stick a 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " photo to the 3  $\frac{5}{8}$ " x 5  $\frac{5}{8}$ " piece of Java CS, using double sided adhesive.
18. Stick the matted photo to the center of the page, slightly overlapping the two previous photos, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
19. Stick a mini tag to the bottom left hand corner of the matted photo with Stampin' Dimensionals.
20. Cluster a yellow and turquoise ruffled flower around the mini tag with hot glue.
21. Stick the Vintage Wire Love Hanger to the cluster with hot glue.
22. Stick the two remaining Mini Kraft tags to the top right hand corner of the matted photo, slightly overlapping each other, with Stampin' Dimensionals.
23. Cluster the two yellow ruffled flowers and one turquoise ruffled flower around the tags, as shown, with hot glue.  
You're done!
