

Exquisitely Yours



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Best Yet (Stampin' Up!)
- **Ink:** Tuxedo Black Memento ink (Tsukineko)
- **Paper:** Terracotta Tile CS (papertrey ink); Pear Pizzazz CS (Stampin' Up!); Vanilla Smooth CS (Bazzill); Olde Curiosity Shoppe Collection DP (Graphic 45)
- **Accessories:** Classic Brackets Edgeabilities dies, Mystic M-Bossabilities, Enchanted M-Bossabilities, Labels Sixteen, Grand Calibur (Spellbinders); Rustic Jute Button twine, Terracotta Tile buttons (papertrey ink); bone folder, Stampin' Dimensionals, ribbon scissors (Stampin' Up!); Tape Runner XL, tiny glue dots (thermo-web); Removable Tape Matte (Scotch); hot glue (Martha Stewart)

Dimensions:

- Terracotta Tile CS: a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece, a 1" x 4 ¾" piece and a 3 ½" x 3 ½" piece
- Pear Pizzazz CS: a 3" x 3" piece and a 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece
- Vanilla Smooth CS: a 2 ½" x 2 ½" piece
- Exquisite Motif DP: a 2 ½" x 4 ⅝" piece
- Race For Time DP: a 2 ½" x 4 ⅝" piece
- Green Ric Rac Velvet ribbon: a 6" piece
- Rustic Jute Button twine: three 2" pieces
- 3 Terracotta Tile buttons

Directions:

1. Fold the 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of Terracotta Tile CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" card base.
2. Stick the 2 ½" x 4 ⅝" piece of Exquisite Motif DP to the 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of Pear Pizzazz CS, leaving equal borders on the top, left and right sides, using double sided adhesive.
3. Stick the 2 ½" x 4 ⅝" piece of Race For Time DP to the 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of Pear Pizzazz CS, leaving equal borders on the bottom, left and right sides, using double sided adhesive.
4. Position the Classic Brackets Edgeabilities "edge" die on the 1" x 4 ¾" piece of Terracotta Tile CS, about ¼" up from the bottom of the CS. You want your cut piece to be a ¾" x 4 ¾" piece. Hold the die in place using Removable Tape Matte. Run this through the Grand Calibur.
5. Stick the ¾" x 4 ¾" die cut strip to the 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of Pear Pizzazz CS, covering the seam from the DP, using double sided adhesive.
6. Lay a 6" piece of Green Ric Rac Velvet ribbon over the ¾" x 4 ¾" die cut strip. Wrap the ends around to the back of the CS and stick them down using double sided adhesive.
7. Center and stick the 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of Pear Pizzazz CS to the card base, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
8. Die cut and emboss a small label from the 2 ½" x 2 ½" piece of Vanilla Smooth CS, using the Labels Sixteen dies and the Grand Calibur. Die cut a medium label from the 3" x 3" piece of Pear Pizzazz CS, using the Labels Sixteen dies

and the Grand Calibur. Die cut a large label from the 3 ½" x 3 ½" piece of Terracotta Tile CS, using the Labels Sixteen dies and the Grand Calibur. You will not be using the largest die in the set, but the next three down.

9. Emboss the Pear Pizzazz CS die cut label, using the Mystic M-Bossabilities folder and the Grand Calibur. Emboss the Terracotta Tile CS die cut label, using the Enchanted M-Bossabilities folder and the Grand Calibur.
 10. Center and stick the Pear Pizzazz CS die cut label to the Terracotta Tile CS die cut label, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
 11. Stamp the greeting onto the top portion of the Vanilla Smooth CS die cut label, using Tuxedo Black Memento ink.
 12. Center and stick the greeting label to the Pear Pizzazz CS die cut label, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
 13. Center and stick the matted greeting label to the card, directly over the ribbon, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
 14. Thread a 2" piece of Rustic Jute Button twine through a button. Stick the twine to the back of the button, using a tiny glue dot. Trim off the ends using ribbon scissors. Repeat with the other two buttons.
 15. Stick the three threaded buttons to the Vanilla Smooth CS die cut label, just under the greeting, using hot glue.
