

Love You



Supplies:

- **Paper:** Taffy CS, Sketchbook Collection DP (Amy Tangerine - American Crafts)
- **Accessories:** Noble Roman Lower Case Alphabet Presto Punch templates, Classic Hearts Nestabilities dies, Grand Calibur, Presto Punch (Spellbinders); black buttons (papertrey ink); Whisper White baker's twine, bone folder, paper snips, mini glue dots (Stampin' Up!); Blackberry Mini Alphabet stickers (My Little Shoebox); wax paper (Dollar Store); tweezers (optional) (Cutter Bee); Tombow multi-purpose liquid adhesive (Tombow)

Dimensions:

- Taffy CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece
- Ebony CS: a 4" x 5 ¼" piece and a scrap piece
- Sienna Spirit DP: a 4 ½" x 4 ½" piece
- Viridian Vignette DP : 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅞" piece
- Whisper White baker's twine: two 3" pieces
- 2 buttons

Directions:

1. Die cut and emboss a heart from the 4 ½" x 4 ½" piece of Sienna Spirit DP using the largest Classic Hearts die and the Grand Calibur.
2. Die cut the letters for the word "Love" from the scrap piece of Ebony CS, using the Noble Roman Lower Case Alphabet dies and the Presto Punch.
3. Stick the die cut heart to the 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅞" piece of Viridian Vignette DP, about ½" down from the top and about ⅜" in from the right hand edge, using double sided adhesive. Trim off the overhanging portion of the heart, using paper snips.
4. Center and stick the 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅞" piece of Viridian Vignette DP to the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of Ebony CS, using double sided adhesive.
5. Fold the 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Taffy CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base.
6. Center and stick the matted 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅞" piece of Viridian Vignette DP to the card base, using double sided adhesive.
7. Stick the die cut letters for the word "love" to the card, about 1 ⅝" up from the bottom of the card, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid adhesive. You want some of the letters to overlap the die cut heart.
8. Using the Blackberry Mini Alphabet stickers, stick the letters for the word "you" to the card, just below the "love" letters.
9. Thread a 3" piece of Whisper White baker's twine through the holes in one of the black buttons. Stick the baker's twine to the back of the button, using mini glue dots. Trim off the ends of the baker's twine, using paper snips. Repeat with the second 3" piece of baker's twine and the other button.
10. Stick the two buttons to the card, in the upper left hand corner of the heart die cut shape, using mini glue dots. You're done!
