## Ribbons & Buttons For You.



## **Supplies:**

- Stamps: Wonderful Words Additions (papertrey ink)
- Ink: Basic Black Craft ink (Stampin' Up!)
- Paper: Pretty In Pink CS, Basic Gray CS (Stampin' Up!); Smooth White CS (Bazzill)
- Accessories: buttons (papertrey ink); buttons, embossing buddy, Stampin' Dimensionals, ribbon scissors, bone folder, white baker's twine (Stampin' Up!); Primary Ebony Superfine embossing powder (WOW! Embossing); Heat It! tool (Ranger); Tape Runner XL, tiny glue dots (thermo-web); Pink Solid/Plaid ribbon, Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon (May Arts); Mystic M-Bossabilities, Grand Calibur (Spellbinders); Fabri-tac (Beacon Adhesives); Tombow multi-purpose liquid adhesive (Tombow); hot glue (Martha Stewart)

## **Dimensions:**

- Pretty In Pink CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece
- Basic Gray CS: a 4" x 5 1/4" piece
- Smooth White CS: a 3 1/8" x 5 1/8" piece
- Pink Solid/Plaid ribbon: three 4" pieces
- Yellow Solid/Plaid ribbon: three 4" pieces
- White baker's twine: six 2" pieces
- 3 yellow buttons
- 3 pink buttons

## **Directions:**

- 1. Fold the 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Pretty in Pink CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base.
- 2. Run an embossing buddy over the 3 1/8" x 5 1/8" piece of Smooth White CS.
- 3. Stamp the greeting in the bottom right hand corner of the 3 %" x 5 %" piece of Smooth White CS, using Basic Black Craft ink.
- 4. Sprinkle the greeting with Primary Ebony Superfine embossing powder. Tap off any excess embossing powder. Heat this with a heat tool until the embossing powder has melted.
- 5. Emboss the 3 %" x 5 %" piece of Smooth White CS, using the Mystic M-Bossabilities folder and the Grand Calibur.
- 6. Fold one end of a 4" piece of Pink Solid/Plaid ribbon in half. Cut the ribbon on an angle, using ribbon scissors. You have now cut an even "V" pattern in the end of the ribbon. Repeat with the five remaining 4" pieces of ribbon.
- 7. Place a strip of double sided adhesive on the back of the 3 %" x 5 %" piece of Smooth White CS, along the top edge.
- 8. Lay the six 4" pieces of ribbon on the 3 %" x 5 %" piece of Smooth White CS, alternating colors and varying the lengths. Wrap the ends of the ribbon over the top of the CS and stick them down to the adhesive.
- 9. Stick the ribbon to the front of the card, using Fabri-tac.
- 10. Center and stick the 3 %" x 5 %" piece of Smooth White CS to the 4" x 5 %" piece of Basic Gray CS, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid adhesive.
- 11. Center and stick the matted 3 %" x 5 %" piece of Smooth White CS to the front of the card, using Stampin' Dimensionals.

- 12. Thread a 2" piece of White baker's twine through the holes in one of the buttons. Tie the ends of the twine into a knot. Trim off the ends, using ribbon scissors. Repeat with the five remaining buttons.
- 13. Stick a threaded button to the card, at the top of each of the ribbon pieces, using hot glue. You want to place a yellow button on the pink ribbon pieces and a pink button on the yellow ribbon pieces. You're done!
