

Just Because Button Card



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** This Is Big (Hero Arts)
- **Ink:** Jet Black Archival ink (Ranger)
- **Paper:** River Rock CS, Old Olive CS, Island Indigo CS (Stampin' Up!); Ebony CS (Bazzill); Memoir Collection DP (Studio Calico)
- **Accessories:** bone folder, mini glue dots, craft scissors, Stampin' Dimensionals (Stampin' Up!); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); Black Zipper trim (Maya Road); red liner tape (Simon Says Stamp); 9 to 5 buttons (October Afternoon); Black Jute (May Arts)

Dimensions:

- River Rock CS: a 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece
- Ebony CS: a 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece
- Old Olive CS: a ½" x 3" piece
- Island Indigo CS: a ⅛" x 3 ⅞" piece
- Wallpaper DP: a 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece and a ½" x 3 ¾" piece
- Flower Bed DP: a ¾" x 3 ½" piece
- Black Zipper trim: a 3" piece
- Black Jute: three 2" pieces

Directions:

1. Fold the 5 ¼" x 10 ½" piece of River Rock CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 5 ¼" x 5 ¼" card base. Set aside for a moment.
2. Stamp the greeting onto the right hand side of the 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Wallpaper DP, about 2" up from the bottom, using Jet Black Archival ink.
3. Center and stick the 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Wallpaper DP to the 4 ¾" x 4 ¾" piece of Ebony CS, using double sided adhesive.
4. Stick the 3" piece of Black Zipper trim to the back of the ¾" x 3 ½" piece of Flower Bed DP, leaving equal borders on the left and right hand sides, using double sided adhesive.
5. Stick the ½" x 3 ¾" piece of Wallpaper DP to the right hand side of the matted 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Wallpaper DP, just below the greeting, using double sided adhesive.
6. Stick the ⅛" x 3 ⅞" piece of Island Indigo CS to the matted 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Wallpaper DP, on an angle, in the bottom right hand corner, using double sided adhesive.
7. Stick the ½" x 3" piece of Old Olive CS to the matted 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Wallpaper DP, in the bottom right hand corner, using double sided adhesive.
8. Stick the Black Zipper trim/Flower Bed DP to the right hand side of the matted 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" piece of Wallpaper DP, in the bottom right hand corner, red liner tape.

9. Thread a 2" piece of Black Jute through the holes on one of the buttons. Stick the jute to the back of the button, using a mini glue dot. Trim the ends of the jute, using craft scissors. Repeat with the remaining two buttons and two 2" pieces of jute.
10. Stick the three buttons to the bottom right hand corner of the matted 4 5/8" x 4 5/8" piece of Wallpaper DP, in a cluster, using mini glue dots.
11. Center and stick the matted 4 5/8" x 4 5/8" piece of Wallpaper DP to the card base, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
