

Boo Spider Card



Supplies:

- **Ink:** Faded Jean, Black Soot, Broken China and Chipped Sapphire Distress inks (Ranger); Black and Silver Sharpie marker (Office Supply Store); White Pan Pastel (Colorfin)
- **Paper:** Bermuda Bay CS, Whisper White CS, Basic Gray CS, Elegant Eggplant CS (Stampin' Up!) unknown DP - glittery swirl pattern (K & Company); unknown DP - skull pattern (Karen Foster)
- **Accessories:** bone folder, Small Oval punch (retired), $\frac{3}{4}$ " Circle punch, paper snips, stamping sponges, sponge dauber, Stampin' Dimensionals (Stampin' Up!); Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue (Tombow); $\frac{1}{4}$ " hole punch (Office Supply Store); Sofft Tool (Colorfin); Standard Circles Small Nestabilities die (Spellbinders); Big Shot, Smoothie Alphabet dies (Sizzix); Caribbean baker's twine (The Twinery); tape (Scotch); Icicle Stickles (Ranger)

Dimensions:

- Bermuda Bay CS: a 6" x 8" piece
- Whisper White CS: a 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece, a 3" x 3" piece and a scrap piece
- Basic Gray CS: eight $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces and a scrap piece
- Elegant Eggplant CS: a 2" x 6" piece
- Glittery Swirl pattern DP: a 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece
- Skull pattern DP: a 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece (the skull pattern)
- Caribbean baker's twine: a 28" piece

Directions:

1. Fold the 6" x 8" piece of Bermuda Bay CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4" x 6" card base.
2. Sponge around the edges of the card base, using a wedge of a stamping sponge and Chipped Sapphire Distress ink.
3. Sponge around the edges of the 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Whisper White CS, using a wedge of a stamping sponge and Broken China Distress ink.
4. Center and stick the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of the glittery swirl DP to the 3 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of Whisper White CS, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue.
5. Cut a fishtail in the end of the 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of the skull pattern DP, using paper snips.
6. Stick the 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " piece of the skull pattern DP to the 2" x 6" piece of Elegant Eggplant CS, leaving equal borders on the left and right hand sides, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue.
7. Cut a fishtail in the bottom of the 2" x 6" piece of Elegant Eggplant CS, leaving an equal mat around the DP, using paper snips.
8. Sponge around the matted skull pattern DP, using a wedge of a stamping sponge and Chipped Sapphire Distress ink.
9. Center and stick the matted 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of glittery swirl DP to the card base, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue.
10. Stick one end of the 28" piece of Caribbean baker's twine to the back of the top of the matted DP flag, using Scotch tape.
11. Wrap the 28" piece of Caribbean baker's twine around the matted DP flag, twice.

12. Stick the matted DP flag to the card, leaving equal borders on the left and right hand sides, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue. Make sure that the end of the baker's twine is on top of the matted DP flag, not getting stuck to the card base. Set aside for a moment.
13. Die cut a circle from a 3" x 3" piece of Whisper White CS, using the third largest die in the Standard Circles Small Nestabilities and the Big Shot.
14. Keeping the die cut circle in the die, sponge around the edges of the CS, using a wedge of a stamping sponge, Broken China and Chipped Sapphire Distress inks.
15. Die cut the letters for the word "boo!" from scrap pieces of Whisper White CS, using the Smoothie Alphabet dies and the Big Shot.
16. Stick each of the die cut letters to a scrap piece of Bermuda Bay CS, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue.
17. Cut around each of the die cut letters, leaving a narrow CS border, using paper snips.
18. Sponge around each of the matted die cut letters, using a sponge dauber and Broken China Distress ink. Set aside for a moment.
19. Punch out an oval from a scrap piece of Basic Gray CS, using a Small Oval punch.
20. Trim the punched out oval by round both sides, using paper snips. This will be used as the spider's body.
21. Punch out a circle from a scrap piece of Basic Gray CS, using a 3/4" Circle punch. This will be used as the spider's head.
22. Sponge around the outside of the spider's head and body, using a wedge of a stamping sponge, Faded Jean, Chipped Sapphire and Black Soot Distress inks.
23. Stick the eight 1/4" x 1 1/2" pieces of Basic Gray CS to the back of the spider's body, four on each side, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue. These will be used as the spider's legs.
24. Add some shadows to each of the spider's legs, using a Black Copic marker.
25. Sponge each of the spider's legs, using a wedge of a stamping sponge, Chipped Sapphire and Black Soot Distress inks.
26. Punch out three circles from a scrap piece of Whisper White CS, using a 1/4" hole punch. These will be the spider's eyes.
27. Sponge around the bottom half of each of the eyes, using a sponge dauber and Broken China Distress ink.
28. Draw on the "pupils", using a Black Sharpie marker.
29. Stick the three eyes to the spider's head, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue.
30. Apply some White Pan Pastels to the top of the spider's head, the top of the spider's body and the top of each of the legs, using a Sofft Tool.
31. Stick the spider's head to the body, using a Stampin' Dimensional.
32. Center and stick the die cut circle to the card, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
33. Stick the die cut letters for the word "boo!" to the card, just above the die cut circle, using Tombow multi-purpose liquid glue.
34. Pull the loose end of baker's twine down over the front of the card and stick it to the center of the die cut circle, using a small piece of Scotch tape.
35. Stick the spider to the card, directly over the scotch tape, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
36. Add some highlights to the spider, using a Silver Sharpie marker.
37. Add some Icicle Stickles to each of the letters in the "boo!" greeting. You're done!
