

Funky For You



Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Bold Mixed Sentiments (Artistique)
- **Ink:** Jet Black Archival ink (Ranger)
- **Paper:** Orange Zest CS; Boys Only 6" x 6" paper pad (Papertrey Ink); Ebony CS, White Smooth CS (Bazzill)
- **Accessories:** Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); paper scissors (Cutter Bee); bone folder (Craft Store); Grand Calibur, Standard Circles Small Nestabilities (Spellbinders); paper trimmer (Fiskars)

Dimensions:

- Orange Zest CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece
- Ebony CS: a 4" x 5 ¼" piece
- White Smooth CS: a 4" x 5 ¼" piece
- Boys Only patterned paper: scrap pieces of three different patterns

Directions:

1. Fold the 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Orange Zest CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base. Set aside for a moment.
2. Randomly die cut circles on the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White Smooth CS, using the three smallest circles from the Standard Circles Small Nestabilities and the Grand Calibur. Repeat until you are satisfied with how many circles are cut.
3. Stamp the greeting in the bottom right hand corner of the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White Smooth CS, using Jet Black Archival ink.
4. Stick a scrap piece of patterned paper behind each of the die cut circles, as shown in the above photo, using double sided adhesive.
5. Trim the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of White Smooth CS down to a 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅛" piece, using a paper trimmer.
6. Center and stick the 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅛" piece of White Smooth CS to the 4" x 5 ¼" piece of Ebony CS, using double sided adhesive.
7. Center and stick the matted 3 ⅞" x 5 ⅛" piece of White Smooth CS to the folded card base, using double sided adhesive. You're done!
